The Aviation Studies Program has been offered at MNCC for 20 years now and while many changes have happened over the vears, this major rebuild project has maintained its position of being a significant example for the students to apply their learning. Over the years, every Aviation class has worked on their own smaller section of this aeroplane, starting with the class of 2006 shown here.

This week, the Aero45 was loaded onto a flat-bed, bound for its next life and purpose in Port Lincoln. This is a very special example of God's providence as the Aero45 was originally tasked as a Tuna Spotting plane out of Port Lincoln, so to see it return home is simply delightful.

It is certainly timely to have new projects coming into our hangar during this year of our 20th Anniversary, replacing the Aero45 place as the lead project of our Aviation Course and giving new life for the next 20 years of budding Aviation students.
